About the Festival

Community School's Strawberry Festival is one of Roanoke's most popular and well-known annual festivals. Each year rain or shine, the Festival is held the first weekend in May in downtown Roanoke's Elmwood Park.

Now in its 29th year, the Festival will run 10:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Friday, May 1 and Saturday, May 2.

These two fun-filled days offer a scrumptious line-up of berry-filled treats, live musical entertainment, children's games and activities and arts and crafts vendors.

The berry sweetest part of the Strawberry Festival is that all proceeds from the event go to Community School, providing tuition assistance to nearly 40 percent of its students.
