Preschool Classes (Katlyn and Sharon):

Please watch for the supply lists for these classes in the teacher mailings going out on August 19.

5-7 Classes (Beth and Jacinda)

To make life easier for all, we are asking for:

- A \$25 gift card from Target, Walmart or Kroger. Your child's teacher will pick up the supplies, as needed, throughout the school year. Please bring the gift card to the Gathering on August 28 or send it the first day of school in an envelope with your child's name on it.

Please send the following items with your child on the first day of school. These items will be kept at school, and each item should be labeled with your child's name:

- A tote bag or back-pack (no wheels), able to hold a standard-sized folder and your child's lunch box.
- Indoor shoes (such as crocs, slip-ons, or slippers)
- Rain boots
- Change of seasonally-appropriate clothes in a ziploc bag (labeled shirt, pants, underwear and socks)

6-8 Classes (Tulie, Cynthia and Nikki)

The 6-8 years old are trying something new this year. To keep our classrooms clutter-free, we will get items such as tissues, paper towels, wipes, glue sticks, etc. as we go. That way we won't have to find storage for 24+ of each of these items in our rooms. So, we are asking for:

- A \$25 Target gift card from each family. We will use these cards to buy supplies as needed.

In addition to the gift cards, each child will also need:

- A pair of rain boots (to be kept at school)
 - A pair of inside shoes that are easy to slip on such as crocs or low-profile slippers (to be kept at school)
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8-10 Classes (Betsy, Kiera and Sarah)

For school:

- A 1/2" or 1" 3-ring binder.

For home only, we suggest:

- Loose leaf writing paper
- Pencils
- Glue
- Tape
- Markers
- Colored pencils
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Stapler
- Construction paper
- A dictionary

Middle School

Daily:

- A nutritious lunch and snack for Fruit Break each day packed in a labeled lunch bag
- Labeled water bottle (that they can fill or refill from our water cooler). Please note that we only have water dispensers in the MS buildings, not water fountains. We are making an extra effort this year to have everyone in our community utilizing reusable utensils, bottles, etc.
- 1 ½-inch, 3-ring binder with dividers with pockets; please fill with paper before school starts. (many of our students like the Case It Mighty Zip Binder)
- Third- and fourth-year students: 1-inch, Clear-Vue binder for humanities class (will be left in class)
- Pens (blue or black) and pencils
- Highlighters - multicolor set
- Zippered pouch for pens and pencils- preferably one with 3 holes to be kept in binder
- Student planner- please have student familiarize themselves with the layout of their planner before school begins
- Flash drive (we recommend one that has a keyring)

Please NO accordion folders at school.

Each advisee list will have an item that will support the whole MS (tissues, antibacterial wipes, packs of paper, paper towels). This information will be in the summer mailing, along with advisee lists.

Helpful things to have available at home:

- A dictionary
- A metric/standard ruler
- A Spanish/English dictionary
- Computer access with internet
- A printer (with ink and paper)
- A designated study space and study time
