



Job Title: Lower Elementary Teacher

About Community School: Community School is a small, secular, independent school for children ages 3 to 14, serving preschool through middle school. Welcoming students from all racial, cultural, religious, and economic backgrounds, we're rooted in progressive education and focused on nurturing the whole child through hands-on learning, an integrated curriculum, and a strong sense of community.

Job Summary: Community School seeks a collaborative, creative, and flexible teacher for our elementary levels. This role involves planning and implementing integrated, developmentally appropriate, inquiry-based lessons that incorporate the school themes and follow our curriculum concepts, working with the elementary team, and completing all necessary paperwork and documentation for our school community. This is an anticipated lower elementary position for the upcoming school year. Final grade-level placement is subject to change based on enrollment and staffing needs.

Responsibilities:

- Plan and implement weekly lessons that are engaging, integrated, and experiential for students in looped elementary levels.
- Follow a progressive education pedagogy, which prioritizes and honors student voice and choice, and allows for reflection and growth
- Meet regularly with the elementary team and full staff
- Complete school paperwork throughout the year to document and communicate with families regarding students' progress
- Communicate class content regularly with families
- Help plan and facilitate field trips and on-campus events (workshops, guest speakers, etc.)
- Cover campus duties, such as lunch/recess duty, etc.
- Maintain a classroom environment that is supportive, kind, and collaborative
- Maintain a clean and functional classroom space
- Provide constructive feedback for students at an age-appropriate level
- Other duties as assigned by Administrative or Executive Directors

**Please note that some of the duties may extend outside of the traditionally scheduled school day*

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree required, preferably in an education-related field
- Experience working in an educational setting, preferably with elementary-aged students
- Strong organizational and communication skills
- Commitment to progressive education, focused on collaboration, integrated curriculum, and experiential learning
- Strong interpersonal skills
- Flexible and adaptable in a collaborative, child-centered environment
